How to apply

Applicants can obtain an application form online here: <http://www.sas.ac.uk/graduate-study/resources-students/student-support-services> or by emailing sas.registry@sas.ac.uk.

Applications should be returned electronically to the SAS Registry. Applicants should not send their applications directly to the Halls of Residence. The Registry will nominate students for a place based on their preferences and the availability.

The Halls Team will write to applicants offering a room at one of the Halls above. A £500 deposit is required to secure a room. The Housing Services Team will request this as part of your acceptance of your offer of a room. There will be a deadline for accepting the offer and paying the deposit.

Early application is advised as there is competition for places and a waiting list will be introduced once the places have been filled.

Disabled, family-sized or couples accommodation

There is different application process for disabled, family-sized or couples accommodation. An earlier deadline is also in operation and fall outside of the School's quota. Part-time students with disabilities are eligible to apply for Halls accommodation.

Housing Advice

The **University of London Housing Services** offers practical help and advice to students and has access to competitively priced private accommodation. In particular, the UoL Housing Services Property Management Unit offers a range of managed self-catering accommodation for full-time postgraduate students. Late-Summer Places

From mid-September each academic year students may apply directly to the Residences for unallocated places. The UoL Intercollegiate Halls Bureau operates a centralised '**Waiting List**' day, which usually takes place on the second Friday in September. Depending on the residence, full-time students, including those not in their first year of study in 2016/17, can apply for unallocated spaces at any hall (on that day only). Part-time students with disabilities that prevent them from studying on a full-time basis are also eligible to apply.
